

#### **HOURS-EXTENDED CARE**

The regular school day runs 8:15AM-2:45PM.
The doors open in the morning at 7:50AM.
After school care is based on need and goes until 5:00PM when running. We align with the public school calendar for holidays and vacations.

#### **HOT LUNCH**

A hot lunch is served on Wednesdays and includes a healthy meal, choice of beverage, and dessert. On Fridays, pizza from a local restaurant is served.

#### SPIRITUAL LIFE

Students attend an age appropriate chapel once a week where they are encouraged to worship and grow in God's grace. Prayer is incorporated in the classroom daily. Each class is also involved in a ministry designed to encourage students to serve others in the world around them. High school students complete community service hours.

# 2024-2025 PROGRAM AND COSTS

### ELEMENTARY: \$5,850+ registration

Our Elementary school encompasses grades 1-6. Core curriculum includes reading, writing, grammar, handwriting, arithmetic, science, and social studies. In addition to core curriculum, elementary students study art, physical education, computer technology, and music. Students in grades 5 and up are also able to learn how to play an instrument. Each classroom supports a local ministry.



### MIDDLE SCHOOL: \$6,100+ registration

Our middle school is a self-contained 7th and 8th grade classroom. Core curriculum includes reading, writing, grammar, arithmetic, science, social studies, and computer skills. In addition to core curriculum, middle school students study art, music, instrumental band, and Latin. The middle school also forms a traveling show known as "LOL" which uses illusions and juggling to share the gospel. The middle school year culminates in a national mission trip.



## HIGH SCHOOL: \$6,100+ registration

Students in grades 9-12 earn credits through our core curriculum and have elective choices such as art, physical education, band, forensics, and woodworking. Seniors and second semester juniors are able to have dual enrollment at St. Joseph's College. Graduates have been accepted to various colleges and universities across the nation.
